- Over 2500 staff across 17 sites






















## Patient Experience Surveys - AWH surgical wards

Overall do you feel you have been treated with respect and dignity?








#### Comments

- An odd time when someone was rude









#### **Emotional support**

If you had any worries or fears was there someone on the staff to talk to?








#### Comments

- Would like to get an overall summary rather than piecemeal information







