## Victorian Audit of Surgical Mortality Notification of Death (NOD) Form



Instructions for completing the NOD: All cases in which a surgeon was responsible for, or had significant involvement in, the care of a patient are within the scope of the audit, whether or not the patient underwent a surgical procedure. The audit includes deaths that occur in a Victorian hospital when: an operation was performed by a surgeon or gynaecologist, regardless of who admitted the patient; the patient was under the care of a surgeon or gynaecologist, and no operation was performed; and a potential anaesthetic component to the death was identified. The surgical surgery, General surgery, General surgery, Gynaecology, Neurosurgery, Ophthalmology, Oral-maxillofacial surgery, Orthopaedic surgery, Trauma, Otolaryngology, Head and Neck surgery, Paediatric surgery, Urology and Vascular surgery.
