1. PURPOSE AND SCOPE

This policy defines the structure and scope of the Australian and New Zealand Audit of Surgical Mortality (ANZASM) Committee. As a Fellowship-based organisation, the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons (RACS) is committed to ensuring the highest standard of safe and comprehensive surgical care for the community we serve through excellence in surgical education, training, professional development and support.

2. KEYWORDS

Australian, New Zealand, Audit, Surgical Mortality, ANZASM.

3. BODY OF POLICY

Beginning as a pilot program at the University of Western Australia in 2001, in 2004 the program was endorsed by RACS Council to be rolled out nationally under the guidance of the ANZASM Steering Committee. The role of the ANZASM Steering Committee was to guide the regional Audits of Surgical Mortality through provision of appropriate governance and to foster a nationally standardized, consistent approach. With an Audit of Surgical Mortality established in each Australian state and territory the ANZASM Steering Committee transitioned to an operational body referred to as the 'ANZASM Committee'. The ANZASM Committee will continue to coordinate the activities of the regional Audits of Surgical Mortality.

3.1 ANZASM Committee

- Will oversee all regional Audits of Surgical Mortality
- Will establish national guidelines and procedures to ensure consistency and standardization across the regional Audits of Surgical Mortality
- Will provide managerial oversight on behalf of RACS over the regional Audits of Surgical Mortality Management Committees
- Will coordinate state and commonwealth Quality Assurance Activity (QAA) protection provisions
- Will be responsible for authorization of the release of deidentified data when requested (these responsibilities maybe delegated to the Chair)
- Will be responsible for the endorsement of all publications or reports generated by the regional Audits of Surgical Mortality or by ANZASM
- Will report to the Research Audit and Academic Surgery Committee
- Will review rolling two-year attendance figures provided at each meeting.

3.2 Membership

As an operational committee, membership of the ANZASM Committee shall be limited to:

- Surgical Director, Research & Evaluation, who shall also act as Chair
- The Clinical Director and/or Chair for each regional Audit of Surgical Mortality
- Other Clinical Colleges involved in the Audit of Surgical Mortality (e.g. ANZCA, RANZCOG).

The following may be in attendance:

- Executive Director Surgical Affairs, Australia
- General Manager, Research, Audit & Academic Surgery
- Manager, Surgical Audits
- Project Leads/Managers for the regional Audits of Surgical Mortality
