Please note the guidelines outlined below.

Guidelines for Abstracts

- The abstracts must not exceed 250 words.
- All abstracts must be typed, single spaced, with a clear typeface.
- The title should be in capitals and underlined and placed at the top of the abstract.
- Author's name should be in capitals, with the name of the presenter indicated by an asterisk (*)
- Referencing or citation lists within submitted abstract must comply with the Vancouver Style of referencing.
- Degrees and positions in departments should not be included, but the origin of the work should be stated.
- The abstract must be clear and brief. Statements should, in general, be impersonal and the first person "I" and "We" avoided.
- Accepted abstracts will be presented at the Victoria Papers Day as a PowerPoint Presentation.

The abstract should be organised as follows:

- 1. purpose of study
- 2. a brief statement of methods
- 3. a summary of results adequate to support conclusions.
- 4. conclusion
